East Surrey Acrobatics Terms & Conditions 2023/2024

- 1. All bookings for East Surrey Acrobatics are set up as bookable termly courses. All termly fees must be paid up front at the time of booking for the term. In exceptional circumstances, payment plans will be set up for families who commit to the whole term of gymnastics & trampolining sessions. Payment plans will not be set up for those who do not agree to the whole termly cost;
- All families are offered the opportunity to a free trial to see how their child gets on before committing to
 a bookable termly course. The 1st set of fees will also have the additional fee of a club leotard added to
 them. This is a mandatory piece of equipment for all those taking part in gymnastics sessions;
- 3. If a member joins mid-term, the course fees will be worked out pro rata for the remainder of term;
- 4. For any member who wishes not to continue during a term, no refund is to be given for the termly course. In exceptional circumstances (ie bereavement/illness), where a child cannot attend, a credit will be placed on the account for when they can return;
- 5. In the event of exceptional circumstances where a child cannot return, a 1-month notice period will be implemented on receipt of a written email/letter to the ESA Head Coach & YMCA Sports & Recreation Manager. After the 1 month period, the remaining fees of the course will be refunded to the family. If set up on a payment plan, the remaining cost of the 1-month notice period will need to be paid in full;
- 6. If any class has to be cancelled by East Surrey Acrobatics a credit will be placed onto the members account to be used for future sessions;
- 7. British Gymnastics membership is a mandatory requirement. Without a valid membership, members will not be allowed to take part in their sessions;
- 8. Childcare vouchers are not accepted for any of the East Surrey Acrobatics activities;
- 9. At the end of the term, existing members will get two-week grace period to renew their space for the following term. After this period, reserved spaces will be removed & opened up to our waiting lists.
